



ASEAN Data Science Explorers 2023 Competition Call for Applications!

I. What is ASEAN Data Science Explorers competition?

ASEAN Data Science Explorers (ASEAN DSE) competition is a data analytics competition organised by the ASEAN Foundation and SAP, which aims to:

- Promote ASEAN awareness, particularly <u>ASEAN 2025</u>: Forging Ahead Together, <u>ASEAN Socio-Cultural Community Blueprint 2025 (ASCC)</u>, and <u>ASEAN Economic</u> Community Blueprint 2025 (AEC);
- Promote United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (<u>UN-SDGs</u>);
- Empower youths across the 10 ASEAN Member States with data analytics skills and other relevant skills such as problem-solving skill, critical thinking skill, analytical thinking skill, collaboration skill, and communication skill;
- Inspire youths across the ASEAN region to take part in tackling pressing socioeconomic issues across the region through data-driven proposals that will contribute to the achievement of the UN-SDGs within the region

ASEAN DSE competition has been endorsed by the ASEAN Senior Officials Meeting on Youth (SOMY) and ASEAN Senior Officials Meeting on Education (SOM-ED) as it supports the achievement of the ASEAN Work Plan on Youth and Education 2021-2025.

II. Who are eligible to participate in this competition?

This competition is dedicated to youths with ASEAN nationality aged 15 to 30 currently undertaking full-time education in educational institutions (high school, polytechnic, universities, etc.) based in the 10 ASEAN countries. III. What participants must do?

In this competition, each team of registered participants (one team comprising two students from the same ASEAN country) is required to develop data analytics storyboards/proposals. They will choose one issue in ASEAN across the six selected SDGs to solve through their data analytics storyboard. 
